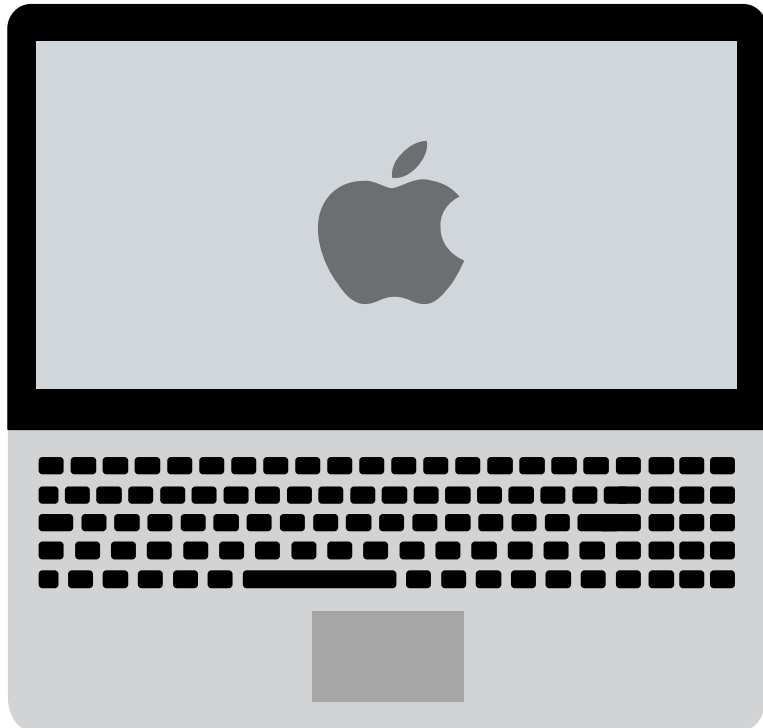


# How to set up a wireless network for MAC OS

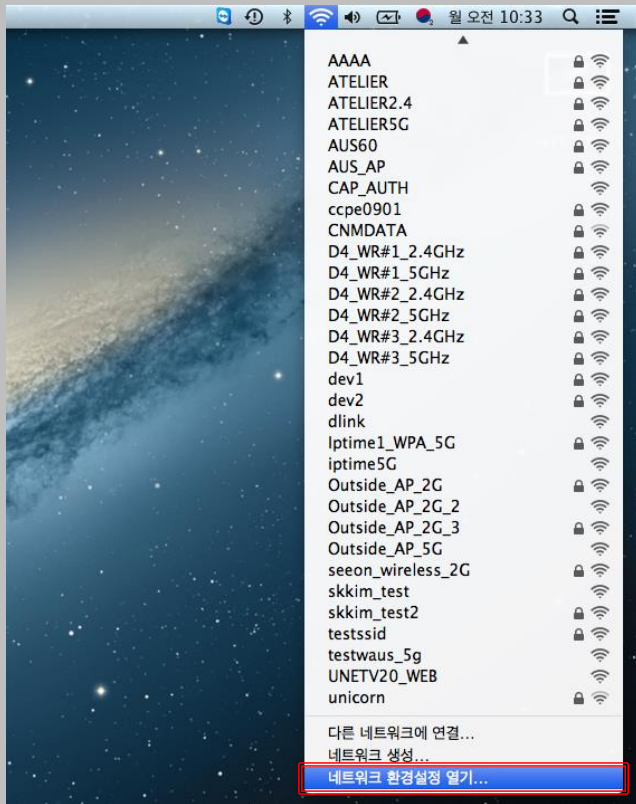


# MAC OS Setting

- MAC OS does not need a separate Agent.

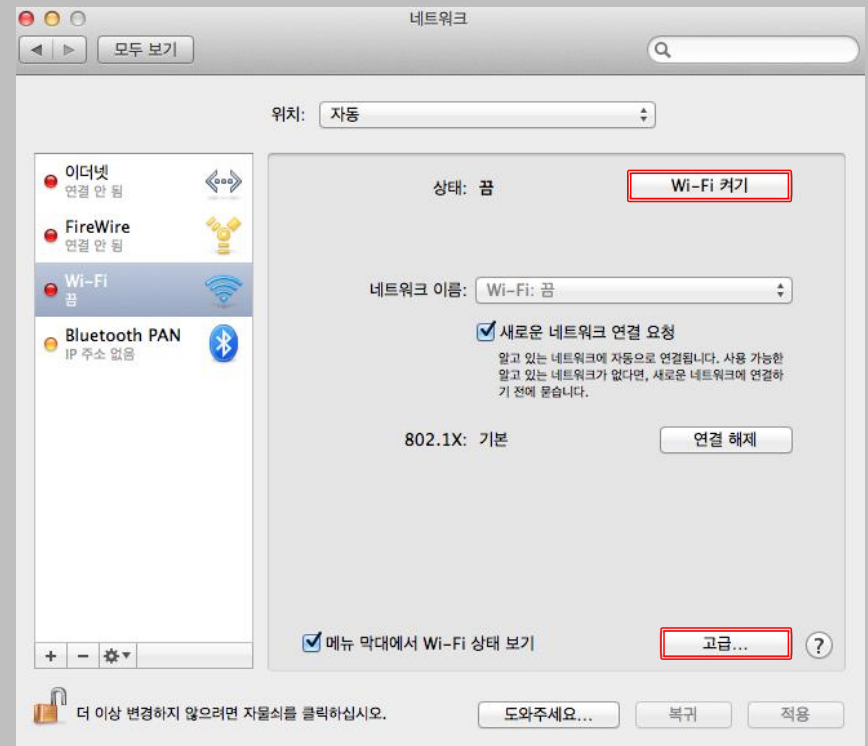
## STEP.01

1. Wireless icons - Opening > Network Settings



## STEP.02

1. WiFi enabled through the Wi-Fi button to turn on
2. Advanced Options (STEP. Continued from 03)

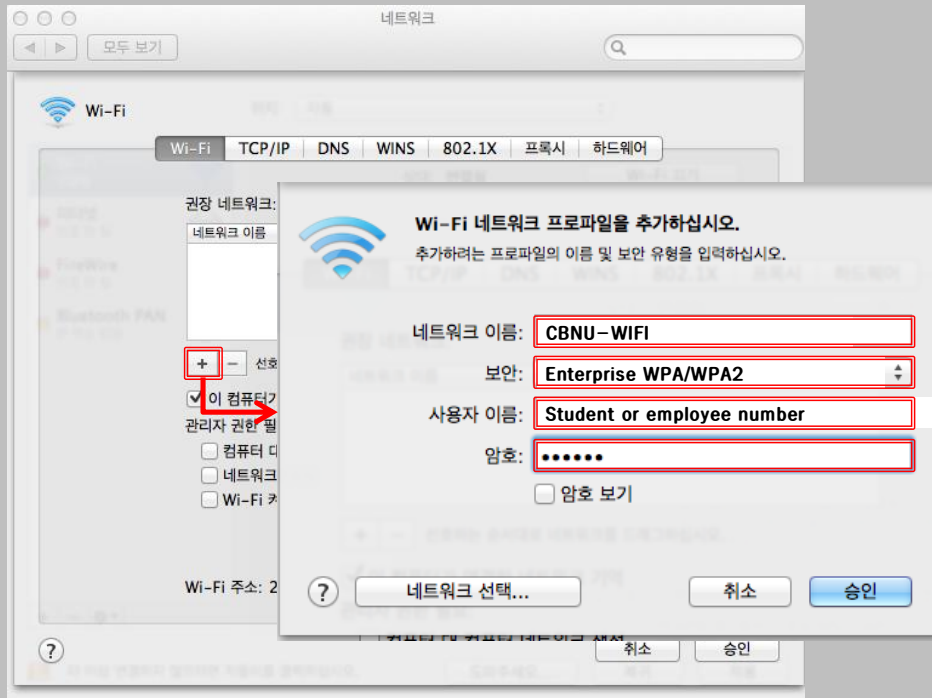


# MAC OS Setting

- MAC OS does not need a separate Agent.

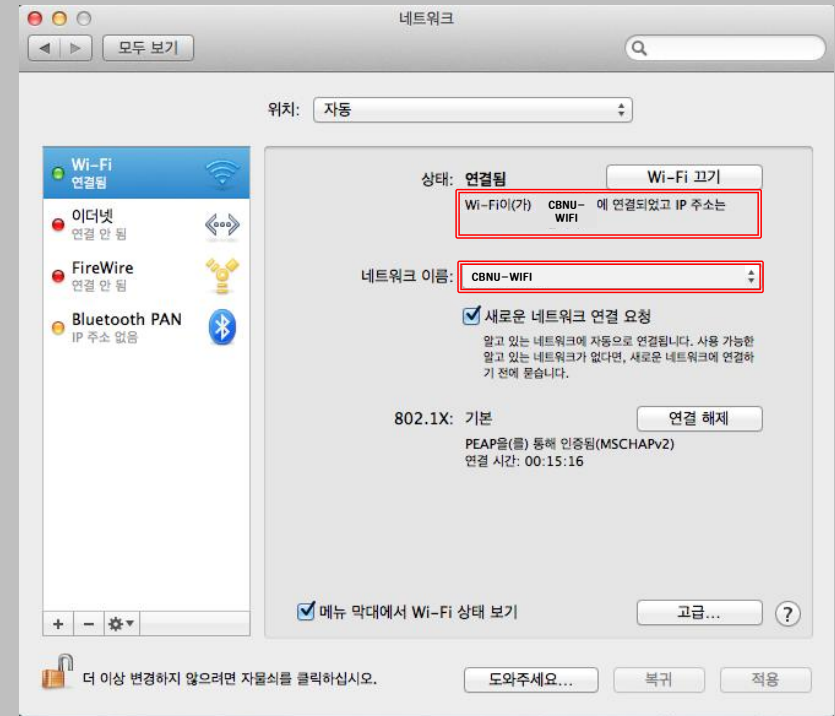
## STEP.03

1. Click the "+" button in the advanced information network
2. Add a Wi-Fi network profile information
  - Network Name: CBNU-WIFI(For Student & School personnel)
  - Security: Enterprise WPA / WPA2
  - User name: Student or Employee Number
